Action Items:

- 1. **Executive Session:** An executive session of the Board was held prior to the start of the regular meeting. The executive session was held to discuss ongoing litigation. No action was taken during the executive session. The executive session ended at 8:30 am.
- **2. April 19, 2024 HCRSD Board Meeting Minutes:** *Motion made by Charlie Crawford, second by Tom Tidstrom, to approve the meeting minutes. Motion approved unanimously.*
- 3. Lanesville Interchange Fuel Center Development (Connection to Existing Sanitary Sewer): Bob Woosley reported he met with the applicant and their contractor since the time of the last meeting. The contractor has found a way to utilize trenchless construction and make a connection to the existing MH in the street without open cutting. The County Engineer was made aware and is in agreement with this approach. Plans are now being revised for submittal to IDEM to secure a construction permit.

- 4. Berkshire WWTP Operations Report (April): Steve Tolliver presented the April operations report. All parameters were met for the month of April. Steve Tolliver stated they continue to see infiltration from the mobile home park's collection system. Steve Tolliver stated there are several delinquent residential sewer accounts that are past due. Steve Tolliver Jr. stated they continue to trouble shoot issues with the pumps at the Star Gas Lift Station. Straeffer Pumps will be on site this coming Monday to perform additional investigation. The station remains in operation while the trouble shooting is completed. The issues at Star Gas has something to do with the triggering of the sensors. The following motions were made:
 - a. Delinquent Bills: A motion was made by Charlie Crawford, seconded by Danny Schroeder to issuing letters of delinquency for any accounts past 90 days due and to have these letters served by the Sheriff's office. Chris Byrd is to draft the letter and state that a lien shall be placed on the property if payment has not been received within 14 days of receipt. Motion approved unanimously.
 - **b.** Operators Report: A motion was made by Tom Tidstrom, seconded by Gary Davis to accept the April operations report and approve a budget of \$300 for the repair of damaged safety cables. Motion approved unanimously.

5. Private Development Updates

- a. Kepley Fields:
 - 1) Patio Homes: The sewer plans have been submitted, reviewed, and approved. The applicant is now submitting to IDEM to obtain a construction permit.
